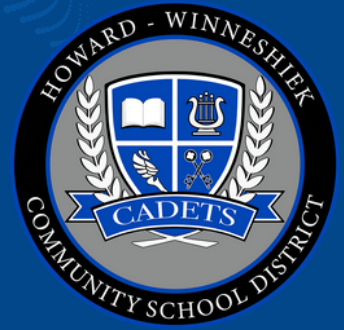

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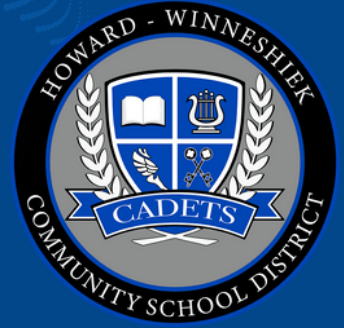
ISASP

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Dropout Rate - Grades 7-12 (Data from 2023-2024 School Year)

- **Overall dropout rate:**
 - 1.18% (6 out of 508 students)
- **Demographic breakdown of Dropout Rate:**
 - 1.92% Students with Disabilities
 - 2.30% Low Socioeconomic Status
 - 3.5% Hispanic/Latino
 - 1.08% White
 - 1.25% Female
 - 1.12% Male

Postsecondary Plans – Class of 2025

- 65.9% of graduating seniors pursued postsecondary education or training
- **Planned pathways:**
 - 35.4% Community college
 - 33% Four-year college

Postsecondary Readiness – Class of 2025

- 13.7% completed the ACT
- 28 seniors participated in work-based learning (job shadows, internships, apprenticeships through CTE/NICC partnerships)
- **Coursework at NICC:** 76 of 82 seniors (92.7%) took courses during high school
- **Credits earned:** 1887.5 total credits by the Class of 2025
- **Credentials earned:**
 - 4 seniors graduated with an Associate of Arts degree
 - 26% earned a Certificate

Core Program Completion

- 100% (82 of 82 seniors) completed the required core program:
 - 4 years of English-Language Arts
 - 3+ years each of Math, Science, and Social Studies
