

Dear Parent/Guardian,



All students entering 12th grade must have proof of having a 2nd dose of the Meningococcal vaccine **before school starts in August**, unless the student has a Certificate of Immunization Exemption on file. There will be **no** grace/extension period for the implementation of this requirement.

The Iowa Department of Health and Human Services made changes to the Iowa Immunization Law which began during the 2017-18 school year. This change requires that all students entering 12th grade show proof of receiving 2 doses of the meningococcal vaccine.

- A medical exemption to immunization may be granted to a student when the required immunizations would be injurious to the health and well-being of the applicant or any member of the applicant's family or household or the required vaccine would violate minimum interval spacing.
- A religious exemption to immunization may be granted when immunizations conflict with a genuine and sincere religious belief, and is not based merely on philosophical, scientific, moral, personal or medical opposition to immunizations. Religious exemptions should not be utilized to prevent truancy issues with students not presenting a valid immunization certificate to enroll in school.

If your student receives immunizations outside of Iowa; please send a copy to the school. If they receive immunizations within the state of Iowa, please contact the nurse as that information can be found in the Iowa database (IRIS).

Now is a great time for your child to receive these immunization requirements and beat the back-to-school rush by making an appointment for your incoming 7th grader. Cresco Medical Clinic is accepting calls and making appointments at this time so please do not hesitate to contact them at 563-547-2022.

If your student receives immunizations before the end of this school year, please send them in and their file will be updated.
